

POLICY NO. 425

IDLE SERVICES

I. OBJECTIVE

Definition of idle service as it pertains to this policy means any part of the distribution lines not needed as a result of the idle service.

II. PROVISIONS

1. Any service that has not been in use for six months shall be classified as an idle service.
2. Owners of idle properties shall be informed, that if they wish the PCRPPD to maintain electric service to these properties, they will be required to pay a minimum service charge. This service charge shall be the sum of the Customer Charge and the Capacity Charge as per the rate schedule for service involved. If this service charge is not paid the PCRPPD may, at its option, remove the service equipment, with the understanding that should the owner at a later date request the service restored, he will be required to pay for the truck expense and the cost of labor of the new installation.

This policy supersedes and cancels all "Idle Service" policies prior to this date.

III. RESPONSIBILITY

The General Manager shall be responsible for the administration of this policy.
