

**POLICY NO. 434**

**RELOCATION OF ELECTRIC FACILITIES AT CUSTOMERS REQUEST**

**I. OBJECTIVE**

It shall be the policy of PCRPPD to relocate electric poles, towers or fixtures after the request of such relocation by a customer or a landowner based upon the following.

**II. PROVISIONS**

1. If such request is reasonable and possible the relocation of the PCRPPD property will be done providing the requesting party will agree to stand the entire cost of such relocation based upon the PCRPPD's costs.
2. The costs for relocation will be based on the labor and mileage rates established by Policy No 433.
3. If the PCRPPD property is in need of rebuilding, relocation may be done on any division of expense between the requesting party and the PCRPPD that the management of the PCRPPD thinks reasonable. The PCRPPD may stand the entire cost of relocation in cases where the line needs to be rebuilt, providing relocation as requested does not substantially add to the cost of such work.
4. Where the existing line, primary or secondary serving an irrigation service needs to be relocated at customer request and the new facility must be underground (example: center pivot). The point of delivery will be the meter and all material and the customer will furnish labor, the PCRPPD will remove its overhead line at no expense to the customer. However; if it becomes necessary to move or alter existing overhead lines to comply with the customer request all charges in paragraph 2 will apply.
5. It is not the policy of PCRPPD to relocate electric facilities at a cost to the PCRPPD in cases where there is no apparent benefit to the public or to the operation or maintenance of such lines by the PCRPPD personnel.

**III. RESPONSIBILITY**

The General Manager and Department Heads shall be responsible for the administration of this policy.
